In 1992 I was director of electronic display system (EDS) operations at Montréal's Olympic Stadium.

The principal tenant was Major League Baseball's Montréal Expos.

I also fulfilled the same function for the Montréal Canadiens NHL hockey team at the Montréal Forum.

The Provincial Government was the stadium's owner and a decision was made to upgrade its electronic display system to state-of-the-art.

I was the overall systems designer and project manager and, following a bidding process, recommended choosing DHD Postimage to design, select equipment for, and build, the video studio.

The entire EDS budget was \$15,000,000.00 and the video portion, handled by DHD, was approximately \$6,000,000.00.

DHD and its staff handled the project flawlessly and subsequent daily use demonstrated that nothing was omitted nor did any glitches ever occur. Sophisticated systems always need a shake-down period during which 'things' appear—but none did!

I would have no hesitation in recommending Dave Donald (indeed, in hiring him again) to put together an elaborate project.
